

Tuesday Ladies Club (TLC)

1. All members should familiarize themselves with the rules of golf, course rules, and rules of etiquette. Please help others in your playing group be aware of the same.
2. Play **READY GOLF**. Be ready when it's your turn. Play out of turn if a player in your group isn't ready. Please keep up to the group ahead of you **or let groups behind you play through**.
3. We will be playing winter rules (also known as preferred lies). You may move your ball **ON THE FAIRWAY ONLY**, within 1 club length to improve your lie, but no closer to the hole.
4. Only members with TLC recognized handicaps will be eligible for weekly prizes. New members must turn in 5 9-hole scores (from any regulation course) to establish a handicap.
5. Members must have 7 recorded play days to be eligible for end-of-the-year awards. 12 golfers must finish play on any given day to constitute a play day that awards weekly prizes. When less than 12 golfers finish, their scores will still count towards handicaps.
6. Putt can: 1st and 2nd flight golfers will pay \$.25 for each hole of 3 or more putts while 3rd and 4th flight golfers will pay \$.15.
7. You may sign up **ONLY** your own foursome for the following week. **NO MORE!!!**
8. Bridge Hole - Pines Back #13. If you hit your ball in the water from close proximity to the bridge, you may carry a ball across and drop it on the other side. Example: Your 4th shot goes in the water, #5 is pulling it out of the water, #6 would be hitting over the water again, instead you carry it just across the water and take a drop there. You'll then be hitting your #7 shot.
9. Oaks Back #14, Tee shot goes in the water. You may go to the drop zone on the left front of the green near cart path for your next shot. It will be your third shot.
10. Oaks Back #15, If you hit your tee shot into the water on #15 you must hit over the water again. You will be hitting your 3rd shot.
11. Oaks Back #16, If you hit your tee shot into the tall reeds in front of the tee box, you may tee up another ball on the tee box for your 3rd shot.
12. Newer Rule Reminders
 - a. A ball hitting a flag stick at any time is no longer a penalty.
 - b. When taking a ball drop, you must drop it from knee height.
 - c. Limit the time when searching for a ball to no more than 3 minutes.
 - d. You may take relief outside a bunker, no closer to the hole, for a 2 stroke penalty.
 - e. Accidentally moving your ball while searching for it or while on the putting green will not incur a penalty, however, you must return the ball to its original position.
 - f. Hitting someone elses's ball is a two stroke penalty
