

Tuesday Ladies Club (TLC)

This is a *Social League*, but you should have some golfing experience to join. There is an annual league fee of \$40 (non-refundable) to be paid before the league begins in May plus the cost each week for 9-holes of golf either with or without a cart. Members will establish a handicap after five (5) weeks of recorded scores or can turn in an established handicap from another golf course. Members will be placed in one of four (4) flights based on their handicap. Each week has a different "game" that is played with the possibility to win prize money in each of the four (4) handicap flights.

Each league season begins with a breakfast on the first Tuesday in May at the course clubhouse and league play starts the following Tuesday. Also there is one luncheon in June, July, and August where the *weekly prizes* are given out. The luncheon is handled by volunteers and a special golf format is played the day of the luncheons with the teams being setup by the volunteer committee. The league banquet occurs on the last day of league play in the evening at a local restaurant chosen by the banquet committee. There is an additional fee for the luncheons and banquet.

League Rules

- ♥ All members should be familiar with the rules of golf, course rules, and etiquette rules. Kindly help others in your group to be aware of the rules (if needed).

See additional Rule Reminders below.

- ♥ Tee times begin at 7 a.m. and run until 9:30 a.m. It is up to you to choose a tee time each week, but not on luncheon days. *After* checking in, sign up yourself or group for the next week.
- ♥ Please notify Edgewood as well as your group's members as soon as possible if you will not be golfing. If your entire group is not golfing any week, *only one group member should call the course* starting after 9 a.m. to schedule the next week's tee time. If you are a single golfer, please join any open tee time slot and get to know the other players.

NOTE: You may ONLY sign up your own group (a 2-4some) for the following week in ONLY one (1) tee time slot.

♥ Please play **Ready Golf** so that you can keep up with the group ahead of you. **Always be aware** of when it is your turn to play and feel free to play out of turn if another player isn't yet ready. You can let the group behind you play through if necessary.

♥ This league plays “winter rules” or “preferred lies”. If your ball lands on a damaged area - **in the FAIRWAY ONLY** - you may move your ball to improve your lie within one (1) club length of the original ball landing, but not closer to the hole without adding a stroke to your score. Otherwise, you must play your ball where it landed.

♥ Only members with recognized TLC handicaps are eligible for the weekly prizes.

♥ *Weekly prizes* are not awarded unless 12 or more players finish a round of 9 holes. If less than 12 members play on a scheduled league day, their scores still count toward their handicaps.

♥ Members must have seven (7) recorded days of league play to be eligible for the *end-of-year* prizes.

♥ WEATHER: Golf will **ONLY** be **cancelled** when the course is closed per Edgewood. The League President will send an email to members upon notification (by 6:30 a.m.) **AND tee times will carry-over to the following week**. Otherwise, it is your choice to golf or not and you must notify Edgewood. If you **DO NOT** golf, tee times for the next week's league play can be made by calling the course starting no earlier than **9 a.m.**

Rule Reminders

- **DO NOT** spend more than 3 minutes searching for your ball.
- A ball hitting a flag stick at any time is not a penalty.
- A ball drop **MUST** be taken from knee height.
- Playing another golfer's ball instead of your own is a 2-stroke penalty.
- You may take relief outside a bunker, but not closer to the hole for a 2-stroke penalty.
- Accidentally moving your ball while searching for it or while on the putting green does not incur a penalty. However, you must return the ball to its original position.

Course Information

Pines Back #13-Bridge Hole: When attempting to get on the green and your ball goes into the water, you may drop a ball on the other side of the bridge on the right side and take an additional stroke.

Oaks Back #14: For a tee shot into the water, you can go to drop zone on the other side of the pond (on the left front of the green just past the wooden stakes) for your next shot. This will be your 3rd shot.

Oaks Back #15: If you hit your ball into the water in front of the tee box, you may either tee up another ball or take a drop on the other side of the water. This will be your 3rd shot.

Oaks Back #16: If you hit your ball into the reeds in front of the tee box, you may either tee up another ball or take a drop on the other side of the reeds. This will be your 3rd shot.
